PURPOSE

To assist a graduate of Lowell High School currently attending Middlesex Community College

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The applicant must be a graduate of Lowell High School.
- The applicant must be taking a minimum 9 credit hours per semester.
- The applicant must have a 2.5 overall grade point average or better.
- Financial need is a consideration but not the major criterion for this scholarship.
- The applicant must demonstrate volunteer hours or community service while attending Middlesex Community College.

AMOUNT OF AWARD

Up to \$1,000 for tuition and other eligible costs

GUIDELINES

One scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis and will be disbursed at the outset of the spring semester. The MCC Foundation, working with the appropriate college committee, has exclusive responsibility for screening all applicants and selecting an appropriate recipient for this scholarship.

TO APPLY

Students applying for Middlesex Community College Foundation Scholarships are required to submit the completed online application at www.middlesex.mass.edu/foundation/scholarships.

Although only one application is required, students are also responsible for reading the individual criteria for each scholarship and submitting the additional required documentation.
