Most of the courses are offered at both the Bedford and Lowell Campuses, with the exception of HUS152 and HUS153 which are offered in Lowell only. Students are urged to meet with their advisor for proper course sequencing.

Students who wish to transfer to a four-year college are advised to take a Mathematics Elective which is at the PreCalculus I (MAT180) level or higher, and a Science Elective which is a four-credit laboratory course. A grade of C or better is required for all Human Service courses.

For the Associate in Science in Human Services Transfer, a total of 63 credits and a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00 are required for graduation.
