- A minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA is required for admission to this major
- A maximum of 68 credits will be accepted in transfer
- A minimum grade of "C-" is required for a course to transfer to Framingham
- Students completing this sequence of Middlesex courses will meet the requirements of the Commonwealth Transfer Compact. As a result, students completing this Associate Degree program are guaranteed a minimum of 60 credits of transfer credit, to be applied to the Framingham Liberal Studies Bachelor of Arts degree as general education courses, courses in the major or free electives.
- Students must complete a minimum of 2-3 concentrations at Framingham to receive a Liberal Studies baccalaureate degree
