Certificate Programs

Certificate programs can serve as the basis for further higher education or professional studies. Certificate programs require students to complete specified coursework, mainly related to particular fields of employment.

While many students enroll in a certificate program in preparation for direct entry into employment, they often return to college, part time or full time, and apply the credits previously earned to an associate degree program.



Milestone Courses

should be taken in the order shown. This will help you stay on track and graduate on time.

General Advising Notes

- This 36 week program is based on 9 week modules, 3 or 4 courses per module, 4 days a week. It is only offered on the Lowell campus during the day.
- Students must successfully pass each module before they are able to move on to the next module.
- Each student will get registered for MAS 099 – Open Lab. This course is 0 credits and is required for students to enroll in.
- Students are able to take ENG 101 – English Composition I, PSY 101 – Introduction to Psychology and MAS 101 – Medical Terminology before entering the program.
- MAS 201 – Externship will take place at an off campus location; students must have reliable transportation. Externships are daytime only.

Career and Transfer Outlook

- Graduates are ready for entry-level employment in various outpatient settings, including hospital clinics, physicians' offices.
- Students who complete this certificate program are eligible to take the national certification exam to become a Certified Medical Assistant.
- After completing this certificate program, graduates may continue on and take additional courses to meet the requirement for the Associate in Science degree program in Medical Assisting.
