General Advising Notes

- IDS 101 First Year Experience is required for all students in this program. This one-credit course is an orientation to the college and the student experience.
- Approved Elective is tailored to students' interests and transfer requirements – often ART or BUS; meet with an Art Adviser.
- In order to maintain a course load of 15 credits, a Summer course is recommended. ART 101 and ART 121 are often offered in the summer, but other ART courses are limited. Therefore, an academic elective such as science, behavioral science, social science or English are also suggested for the summer course.
- ART 185 is often completed in the summer.
- The prerequisites to ART 181 are as follows: ART 151, ART 171, ART 161, and ART 165.
