General Advising Notes

- CRJ 111 is a pre-requisite for CRJ 112 and CRJ 231.
- ENG 101 is a prerequisite for CRJ 131 and CRJ 151.
- Students are encouraged to take Math in their first semester to allow time for completion.
- CRJ 112 is a prerequisite for CRJ 152.
- Students can choose any course as a Free Elective including any CRJ course.
- Students who plan to enroll in CRJ 241 as a CRJ elective must complete the prerequisite for this course, CRJ 152.
- Students are advised to take CRJ 151 after completing at least one other CRJ course, preferably CRJ 111, and not to postpone enrolling in it until the last semester.
- CRJ Electives are:
 - CRJ 100 – Law and Order
 - CRJ 121 – Contemporary Policing
 - CRJ 122 – Juvenile Justice Process
 - CRJ 123 – Terrorism and Homeland Security
 - CRJ 131 – Constitutional Law
 - CRJ 152 – Criminal Evidence & Court Procedure
 - CRJ 153 – Law, Justice and Society
 - CRJ/SOC 156 – Society and Victims of Crime
 - CRJ 231 – Principles of Corrections
 - CRJ 241 – Criminal Investigations
- Humanities are courses with the following prefixes: ART, COM, DAN, ENG, ETH, HUM, LAN, MUS, PHL, REL, THE.
- Science Electives are courses with the following prefixes: BIO, CHE, ENV, PHY, SCI.
