General Advising Notes

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The courses in this program are designed to be taken in a specific sequence. - IDS 101 First Year Experience is required for all students in this program. This one-credit course is an orientation to the college and ideally should be taken before starting the program (usually in August).
- COM 223 Communication Internship can be completed over the summer.

Career and Transfer Outlook

Upon completing this program, students are prepared to pursue careers in various communication fields, such as television/film production, radio, public relations, journalism, social media, corporate communications, and media production.
