- Admission to the dental hygiene program requires the completion of college-level Anatomy & Physiology I & II (BIO 231 and BIO 232) with a grade of "B" or higher (83% or higher) within the last five years.
- Admission to the dental hygiene program requires the completion of college Chemistry (CHE 131) with a grade of "B" or higher (83% or higher) within the last five years.
