- Students who have completed the Medical Assisting Certificate will be able to substitute MAS 102 for AHP 104.
- AHP 105 is offered in an accelerated nineweek format on Saturdays, Jan.-March and May-July.
- AHP 108 is offered in an accelerated nineweek format on Saturdays, Jan.-March and May-July.
- AHP 220 and AHP 225 are only offered in the spring semester. AHP 220 is offered in the first half of the spring semester and AHP 225 is an internship in the second half of the spring semester.

## Career and Transfer Outlook

- Graduates of the Healthcare Administration program are prepared to be employed on the business side of health care facilities such as hospitals, health insurance companies, longterm care facilities, rehabilitation centers and community-based clinics.
