- The A.S. Visual Design (Career) degree prepares students for direct workforce entry.

Career and Transfer Outlook

The Visual Arts Associate of Science Degree prepares students to transfer into a Bachelor of Arts degree program in Visual Arts (including studio arts, photography, design, and media), Art History, or Art Education.

This program qualifies for MassTransfer, which guarantees credit transfer to Massachusetts state universities and the University of Massachusetts. Academic advisors and transfer counselors work closely with students to plan course selections in accordance with their intended bachelor's degree major and transfer institution. A visual art degree program prepares you for various career opportunities, including working as a professional artist, art educator, art therapist, art historian, curator, gallery or museum professional, art director, or illustrator, among others.
