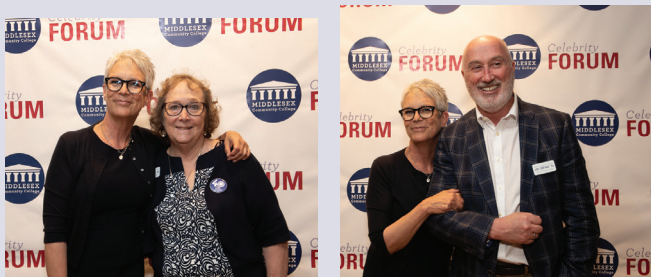
Middlesex Alumni Association members were active this spring and summer raising funds for MCC Foundation scholarships, representing the college at community events, and growing the network of Middlesex alums.

Class of 1999

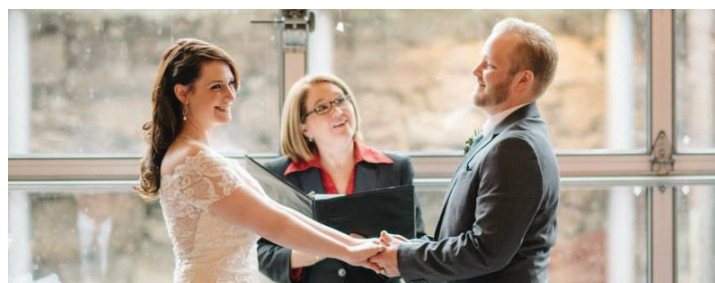
