The Living the Dream award recognizes an individual, organization, or event that meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Perform exemplary deeds of service in the Greater Lowell Area;
- Help individuals and/or their community through one or more extraordinary acts;
- Promote peace, unity, and diversity;
- Make efforts to combat long term, persistent problems that impact entire communities (*for example those who have taken innovative steps to address hunger, homelessness, lack of access to health care, and other issues*).

All nominations must include a 250-500 word nomination essay that details how the nominee meets the criteria listed above, and why they should be recognized at the annual Living the Dream Celebration.
