



Hyflex Learning IS:

- One course, multiple teaching modes (online and face-to-face)
- Faculty in the classroom engaging students, both online & in-class
- Inclusive, reusable, and accessible
- building a community of learners engaged with similar goals
- Adaptive to student's needs (allows flexibility for busy students)
- Equivalent, but the learning process may differ depending on the activity
- Based on Quality Matters standards
- The future of online and face-to-face learning

Hyflex Learning IS NOT:

- Two separate classrooms or two different courses. Students have class discussions, group work & activities together using breakout groups, google docs, Mentimeter and other multimedia tools.
- Isolating for online students. Students online are engaged with others through Zoom, Collaborate, Blackboard, and digital engagement tools.
- Restricted to one choice--either online or F2F for the semester. Students choose the option that best fits their needs each week.
- Limited to the class meeting time. Student learning can continue outside of the classroom using Blackboard as the place to host additional materials.
