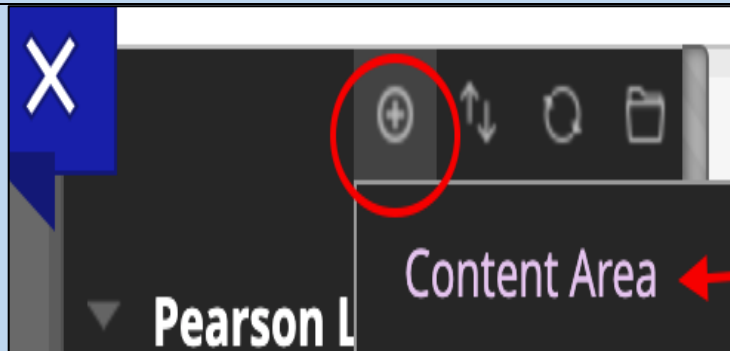


## Pairing Pearson with your Blackboard Course

### This is a new version (1.3) Pearson integration—follow these new instructions:




- Do not copy My Lab & Mastering Pearson content from one course into another semester's course. This will NOT work properly.
- Follow the steps below to create your new Pearson course which will be paired with Blackboard.
- **Set up your new course, including assignments/tests and you must set your dates in the Pearson application (not in Blackboard).**

*IMPORTANT SIDE NOTE: For the next semester (Spring 2023) when you copy your Pearson course in Bb to the new Bb course shell—deselect the “Pearson tab”, otherwise you will create duplicate grade center columns that can not be removed.*






Add a Content Area to your Blackboard Course menu.  
Select the circle/+ icon>then select Content Area  
Type in the name “Pearson”>make it available>click SUBMIT





## Pairing Pearson with your Blackboard Course

		<p>Scroll down to the bottom of the list and select “Pearson”. Do not select “Pearson link” at this point.</p>



### Grade Sync:

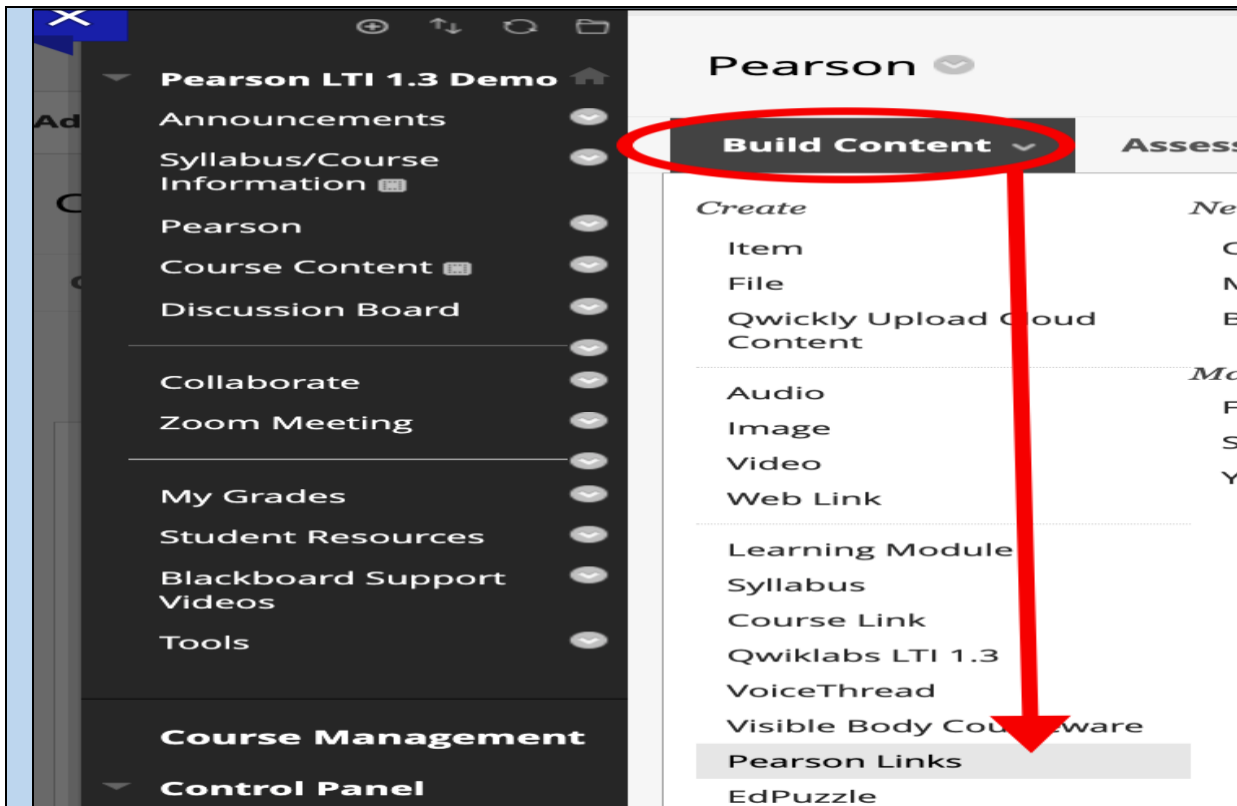
Turn on "Automatic Grade Sync"

\*If you want the grades to Sync now, select sync grades now (blue button).

**\*\*Note from Pearson: (If needed ONLY) - *Disable grade sync in Pearson* in order to delete any Pearson grade columns in Bb that you do not want or are duplicates. Delete all Pearson grade columns in Bb and start over.**

**STEP 2:** If you want to create “**deep linking**”, then you can also add “**Pearson Links**”.

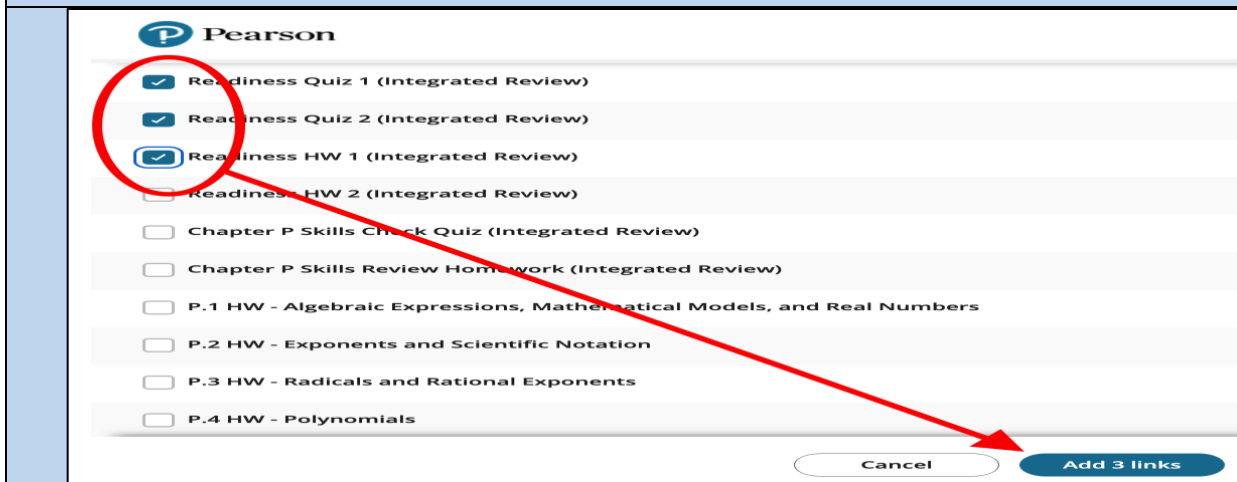
Label this “Pearson Direct Links”

\*Deep linking takes students directly to their assignment, so the page to the assignment opens up. Verses no deep linking, then students have to find the assignment to complete it among all of the assignments.

Some Faculty prefer the ease that deep links provides for their students.

Place this link in the same place as the “Pearson” materials.



Label the Pearson links “Pearson Direct Links”



Select the assignments that you wish to “deep link”.

Then select the blue button to add the “links”.
