

Annotating in Perusall (in Safari) Using an iPad (both students and instructors)

Function: This tutorial will show you how to annotate in Perusall, the group-annotating software program, on an iPad. It's slightly different when using an iPad versus laptop. Typically on a laptop, you would highlight to make a comment. On an iPad, we're going to use the "Annotate Figure" feature (as opposed to the "Annotate Text" feature) and drop pins where we want to create viewable comments.

1. First, log into Perusall and select the reading you wish to annotate. (This may appear slightly different in the student view.)
2. Then, when you're ready to post a comment, click the "Annotate Figure" icon (or, the icon of the little mountain with a sun, next to the "Annotate Text" icon (or the letter "A") to "drop a pin" into the reading.
3. Click on the text where you wish to drop a pin, or a marker indicating a comment.
4. When you simply press on the screen where you wish to drop your pin, the comment box opens.
5. You can then begin typing your comment.
6. Be sure to hit the enter or return key so that others can view your comment.
7. If you change your mind, simply hit the little trash can icon.
8. Then, collapse the right sidebar or "Current Conversation" and scroll down to read more and make your next comment.
9. As you can see, after you comment, the program defaults to the "Annotate Text" or "A" icon, so you need to select the "Annotate figure" or little mountain each time you wish to make a new comment.
