VoiceThread is an external tool that integrates into Blackboard.</p>

Registered users can also upload videos for free.</p> <p>After creating your screencast-o-matic video, you can upload it to You Tube as “unlisted”. Store your mp4 and videos as “unlisted”. Later, you can access the video link to embed it in your course. “Unlisted means no one can see your content unless you share the link with them directly.</p>	<p>Audacity https://audacitydownload.com/</p> <p>Audacity is a free and open-source digital audio editor and recording application software, available for Windows and macOS/OS X. This is a good tool for creating Podcasts for your online course.</p>	<p>MindMeister https://www.mindmeister.com/mind-map-pricing</p> <p>#1 Mind Mapping Tool Capture, develop and share ideas visually. First 3 are free.</p> <p>Students can use for brainstorming, note taking, project planning and tons of other creative tasks. MindMeister is web-based, which means there's no download and no updating! Whether you're working on Windows, Mac OS or Linux, you can always access your mind maps right inside the web-browser.</p>

That means you can use the images and edit them for free, without asking permission from the photographer or website.</p>	<p>Google Drive Storage https://www.google.com/intl/en_au/drive/</p> <p>Google Drive is a safe place for storing files (mp4 video files) and putting them within reach from any device. It allows users to store files on Google servers, synchronize files across smartphones and computers, and share documents. You can easily invite others to view, edit, or leave comments on any of your files or folders.</p>
