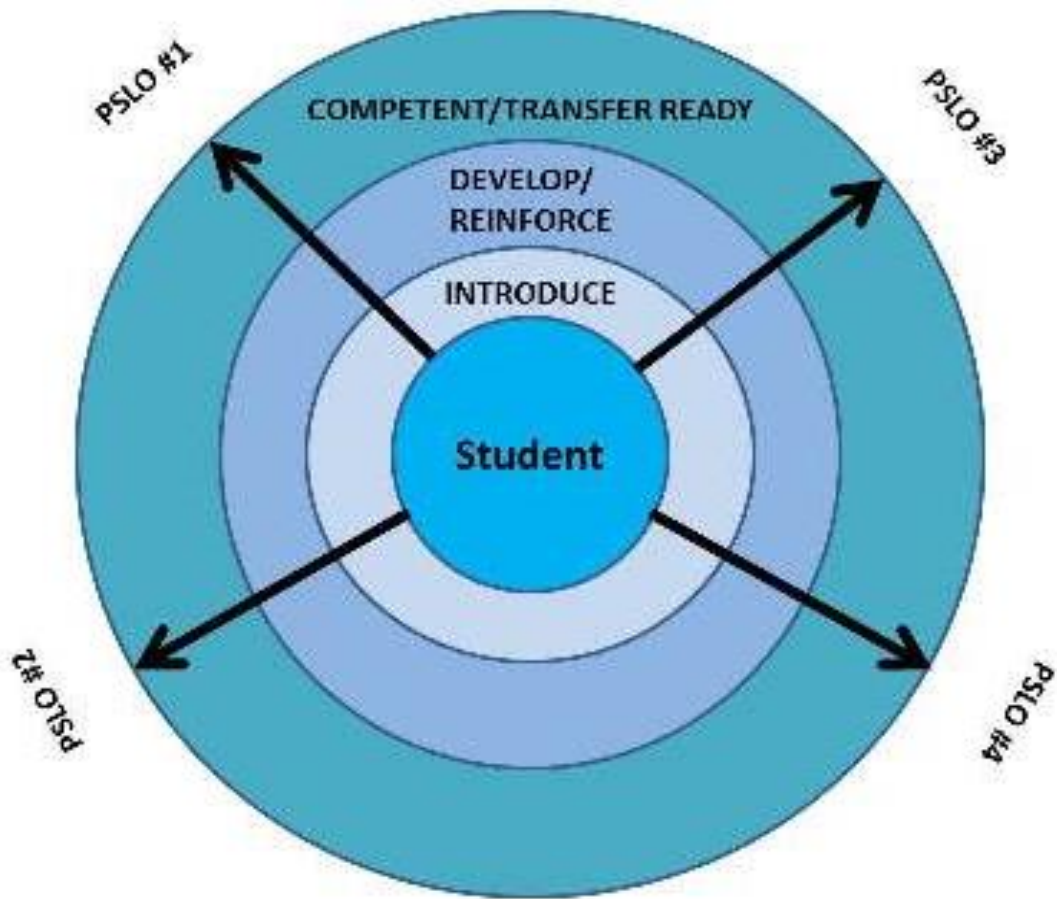


Thinking about your PSLOs, your courses and your students' learning

Applying perspectives/concepts to new material
Creating new material, approaches, knowledge
Practical application of skills to solve problems

I = Introduces skills and concepts relevant to the outcome

D = “Develops by Doing” – students engage in learning activities intended to develop competency/fluency with the outcome

C = “Transfer-Ready Competency” – sophomore and/or Associate Degree level of complexity and fluency. Courses that support a PSLO at this level generate student artifacts that can be assessed to validate student achievement of the PSLO.
